The Gospel of Jesus the Christ

John 3:16 For God so loved the world (you) that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.

Every living person has sinned against the loving God who created them. Because God is holy, righteous, and his word is truth, a sinner cannot live in his presence. In his mercy, God does not allow mankind to live forever in sin. The final payment for a life of sin is death, and after death comes judgement.

Jesus is the son of the living God, and only he could make atonement for our sin, because he is the only perfect, blameless and worthy sacrifice that could overcome our sin. So, he became the son of man, lived a sinless life, and was unjustly crucified. He took the wages of our sin upon himself. But Jesus overcame the grave. He was raised to life again on the third day. He took our sin, so that we could have his everlasting righteousness!

One sacrifice, for all, forever!

We can be raised into everlasting life as well, by believing in Jesus. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord!

How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation?

Romans 10:9-10 If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart, that God has raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.


In Christ alone, our sin, guilt and shame is completely forgiven.

Confess your faith in Jesus Christ and receive the Holy Spirit.




Many people think

But the Bible doesn't teach that.


That is not found anywhere in scripture.
